



Our Mission

Pesach Tikvah was established with the goal of helping people achieve peace of mind. By providing a wide array of therapeutic services for behavioral health and developmental disabilities, Pesach Tikvah aims to help every person reach a state of complete wellness. The growth we've seen over the past 40 years, is a testament as we continuously strive to reach our goal.



Forty years ago, Pesach Tikvah was founded by people who wanted to change the way the Heimishe community related to emotional struggles. Back then, people in our community brushed their emotional struggles under the rug and lived with pain and shame. Our founders wanted to offer our dear community a resource for health and healing that was sensitive to our culture, and in 1983 Pesach Tikvah was born.

Their mission was simple: to give people hope by showing them that they didn't have to live with ongoing emotional pain. Forty years later, our founders have seen thousands of people walk through the doors of hope at Pesach Tikvah and go on to live healthier, happier, and more meaningful lives.

As Executive Director, I am continuing to fulfill the vision of our founders. My mission is to deliver the highest level of mental health care in a way that honors the humanity of every person who encounters Pesach Tikvah. 
The Right Fit

Group Therapy



Our recently renovated Kensington and Flatbush location is the original clinic serving Borough Park, Kensington, Flatbush, and Crown Heights. This clinic employs therapists of many hashkafas so that people from each community can culturally relate to their therapists.



5309 18th Ave Family Center

The 5309 Family Center is a state-of-the-art built-to-suit outgrowth of the 4111 Family Center. It is now our flagship location in Borough Park, employing 60+ clinicians who benefit from its sophisticated learning environment. Evidence-based, modern, effective group therapy is a feature of this location, including Dialectical Behavioral Therapy and parenting groups. The 5309 Family Center has a group therapy room, serene individual therapy rooms, recreational space, and play therapy room. As always, therapy is culturally sensitive and confidential.







Our addiction counseling program, Hearts and Minds, aligns with our values: we aim to help people attain a state of wellness in body and mind through high quality, confidential care from inside the community.

Holistic Approach to Recovery

Recovery from addiction is a new way of life. Outpatient recovery at Pesach Tikvah is based on evidence-based practices, customized for each person. Not everyone starts in the same place – we all have different backgrounds, strengths, and struggles. Every story matters, every story counts, so the approach to each person is specialized.

Pesach Tikvah treats the whole person. We know that alcoholism, substance use, misuse of the Internet, and gambling are connected to mental health and family issues. Our approach is to nurture our clients with one-on-one counseling, education and skill building, group counseling, and mental health support for both the client and the client's family. If medication is appropriate for a co-occurring mental health condition, our on-staff psychiatrists are available to guide each person toward a path of healing.

What Heart and Minds Clients Receive

Hearts and Minds clients receive a suite of compassionate, private, client-centered therapies. These therapies include:

- Individual recovery counseling
- Group recovery counseling
- Individual psychological therapy
- Group psychological therapy
- Medication support if applicable
- Therapy for family members



Recovery Support Services

Pesach Tikvah' s recovery services are designed to get individuals on the road to recovery, and to help them to stay on that path. We offer ongoing help for maintaining long-term sobriety and emotional well-being. One-on-one therapy and medication management are the cornerstones of our recovery support services.

Support for Families

Alcoholism, substance abuse, Internet misuse, and gambling affect the whole family, so Pesach Tikvah offers support to the loved ones (parents, children, siblings, caregivers) of people who struggle with these issues. Our compassionate and empathetic therapists are here to provide confidential support for the whole family. We offer individual and couples counseling, as well as play therapy for children. All our family services are completely confidential.



Home-based Mental Health Services

These services integrate the therapeutic process into the home and provide support to clients and caregivers.professionalism within state-of-the-art facilities, Pesach Tikvah ensures an optimal experience.

Care Management Services: Health Homes

The Health Home Care Management Department is a team of experienced care managers who guide and provide a shoulder to lean on to support the chronically mentally ill with their personal and health related goals. Care managers make care plans that may include goals such as finding better housing, a better job, better treatment (psychological and physical), addressing family needs, legal needs, and other goals.

Adult HCBS and CORE Programs

For eligible Medicaid clients with a history of mental health diagnoses, Pesach Tikvah's CORE program (Community Oriented Recovery and Empowerment) and HCBS program (Home & Community Based Services) offer a customized array of services based on each client's needs. Providers can meet with clients in their homes or community settings. Services provided include: job counseling and ongoing workplace support, educational support, daily living skills support, peer support, in-home counseling, and social skills counseling.

Children and Family Support: Simpatico

The Children and Family Support Services are a unique suite of pre-therapy rehabilitative services. Simpatico offers mentoring and creative expression groups for children in all five boroughs of New York City, and Long Island. This program focuses on teaching your child to connect to himself or herself, so that he or she can connect to others. Simpatico takes place in school, at home, or out in the community. This program offers a holistic and creative approach.

Kochvei Tikvah Seminary





Geriatric Services



Supportive Community

Pesach Tikvah employs the unique "Supportive Community" model to maximize the physical and emotional well-being of the many Holocaust survivors residing in Brooklyn, New York. Trained staff and volunteers make hundreds of visits to Holocaust survivors each month. They provide much needed emotional support and stimulation, telephone support, group activities, social events, oneon-one art, drama, and music therapy, behavioral health support, advocacy, case management, and activity packages. The Supportive Community also provides light handyman services to survivors, free of charge. This includes changing light bulbs, adjusting heat and air-conditioning, and minor repairs.

Home-Based Geriatric Mental Health Services

In order to ease the pain of
Holocaust survivors, Pesach
Tivkah sends Yiddish speaking
counselors to the homes
of these seniors, assisting
them with the traumas
that still affect them.
Experts in the mental
health field are
consulted, as needed,
to help deal with
depression, and the
long-term effects
of post-traumatic
stress disorder.

Friendly Visits

Maintaining independence is crucial for the morale of the seniors. Pesach Tikvah coordinates a group of devoted volunteers who make a minimum of one weekly visit to the home of a local Holocaust survivor. The volunteers chat, check on their welfare, run errands for them, and assist them with hobbies or other special interests.

Outings for Holocaust Survivors

Pesach Tikvah sponsors group outings and events for Holocaust survivors. These outings and events offer the survivors and their caregivers an opportunity for camaraderie and friendship.

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
